Greater Cambridge Local Plan Consultation

It is a very exciting time for Cambridge City and South Cambridgeshire District Councils, as we are preparing a new joint Local Plan which will affect the future of Greater Cambridge over the next 20 years.

The Councils are carrying out a public consultation called: **Greater Cambridge Local Plan – The First Conversation: Issues and Options 2020**. This consultation is the start of the conversation about the kind of place we want [Greater Cambridge](#) to be in the future. It explores the ‘big themes’ – including climate change, biodiversity and social inclusion – that will influence how homes, jobs and infrastructure are planned, and where growth might go.

Our consultation runs between **9am on 13 January and 5pm on 24 February 2020**. Details of where you can view the consultation documents and how to submit comments can be found in the enclosed public notice.
