### Consultation to engage in. Final deadline is 31<sup>st</sup> March

#### Stop Cambridge Road Closures!

*I call for a halt to the City Deal's plan for road closures in Cambridge, and for the opening up of a wider, fairer consultation that includes all options to tackle congestion.*

Not only did we defeat this plan, but after 2 years, the City Deal (now known as the Greater Cambridge Partnership) has **finally** agreed to treat the public like adults and consult on **all** the feasible alternatives for solving the congestion problem.
